

Precision Attachments

Two-part denture is denture care of the highest quality.

A perfect fit and excellent wearing comfort are made possible by special attachment techniques. Examples of these are double crowns (telescopes) or crowns and implants in conjunction with precision mechanical auxiliary parts which work according to the principle of a press stud.

The Attachment Prosthesis consists of crowns with attachment (fig.1,2), i.e. a combination of permanently fixed and removable dentures. The front teeth, for example, are fixed in place by crowns or bridges. The removable section of the denture (fig.4) is attached to the crowns by invisible precision mechanical auxiliary parts called abutments. (fig.3)

The fit and handling of the attachment are ideal. Most aesthetic requirements can also be taken into account. When the prosthesis is removed from the mouth, the fixed crowns remain in place, so that there are no cosmetic disadvantages. (fig.5)

The correct fitting of the prosthesis should be checked at regular intervals by your dentist

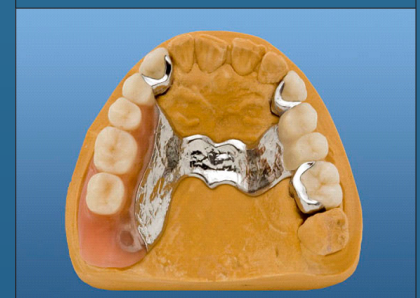
